WMPI Pty., LLC is a Pennsylvania Company founded in Schuylkill County with its offices in Gilberton. WMPI Pty., LLC was incorporated for the purpose of developing coal-to-liquid fuels projects. The company's first project will be located on a seventy-five acre site adjacent to the existing Gilberton Power Plant just north of Interstate 81 and about two miles east of Route 61 and Frackville, Pennsylvania.

The project will use coal waste and raw coal to produce clean liquid fuels and to replace imported oil. In addition, the project will also produce electricity. The coal waste will be beneficiated to remove excessive rock and slate and then delivered to the facility where it will be gasified to produce synthesis gas, known as syngas, made up primarily of carbon monoxide and hydrogen. A portion of the syngas will be used to produce electric power and steam while the remainder will be converted into liquid hydrocarbon fuels that are considered a premium ultra clean transportation fuel.

The total estimated cost of the Gilberton project is \$612 million. The project will create over 1,000 construction jobs during the building phases of the plant, and 150 permanent jobs will be created to run the plant.

In addition to the Gilberton, Pennsylvania site, WMPI is also reviewing potential project site locations in Virginia, West Virginia, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Colorado, Montana, and Wyoming.
